Membership Dues (High Holiday Seats and Oneg Sponsorship are included with membership)

Rates are per child. First two children currently in school are charged at full rate. Tuition is discounted 50% for additional children.

Scrip Obligation

The scrip program gives you dollar for dollar value in gift cards (currently Shop Rite, Acme, and Cherry Hill Kosher) while supporting the shul, thereby reducing dues and eliminating a building fund. Families are asked to buy an average of \$200 per month (\$2400 per year), and those living alone and retirees an average of \$100 per month (\$1200 per year). At the end of the year, members will be invoiced for 5% of their unmet scrip obligation.

Dues Payment Schedule

Invoices will be mailed in July. Payment options include:

- (A) Pay in full by August 20, 2008 by check.
- (B) Pay at least one-half of membership dues and full religious school tuition (75% if two or more children) by August 20, 2008. Balance of invoice is due on or before December 1, 2008.
